- **Become a Precinct Chair:**

- The Precinct Chair is the most important position in the party. The Precinct Chair is the official representative in the precinct; carries the party's message and represents the precinct at the county executive committee meeting. Duties include:
 - Educates voters about the Democratic Party and candidates
 - Help get out the vote during early vote & election day
 - Commit to recruit additional Election Day Volunteers
 - Holds precinct convention at 7:15pm on Primary Election Day
 - Insures every vote is counted
