Re-elect Governor Dave Freudenthal:

Early Polling Shows that Democrats are Poised to Win:

- Gov. Dave is one of the nation's most popular governors. In September, his job approval rating was 69% according to a SurveyUSA poll.
- Meanwhile, George W. Bush's approval ratings have hit a new low in the state. Among independent voters, his job approval is 40%.
- Wyoming is ready for a change in Congress. In October, 54% of the state's voters told SurveyUSA pollsters that the country is headed in the wrong direction.
